Policy 71101.04 states:
"If less than a 2.0 average is achieved, two options are presented to students' parents:

1. To be ineligible for the activity for a minimum of one grading period and achievement of 2.0 average.

OR
2. To be placed on probation for the following grading period.

If the probation option is selected, the student will retain his/her eligibility for extracurricular activities. ...a student can use probation as many times as needed, provided the student receives a 2.0 at the grading period before probation can be used again. The student must also pass four class during the previous grading period in order to use probation. Students will not be penalized, or have a course grade lowered, because of ineligibility to participate in related extracurricular activities."
